Our future leaders will help shape the future of dermatology and venereology for decades to come. Following two successful editions with almost 60 enthusiastic participants, we are proud to announce that applications are open for the 2022-2023 <u>Leadership Development Programme</u>.

The programme offers the unique opportunity to develop the emotional intelligence skills that differentiate a successful leader: the ability to motivate yourself, to engage others in a shared vision, to resolve conflicts and to influence decisions. Now more than ever we realise the importance of equipping our future leaders to navigate challenging and rapidly-changing times.

The EADV Leadership Development Programme, based on the principles of Emotional Intelligence outlined by Daniel Goleman, is built upon collaboration between Beyond Emotional Intelligence, experts in leadership development and the EADV Executive Committee.

The programme includes both online and in-person modules:

- Preparatory assessment (ESCI) and post-ESCI assessment to provide a baseline for participants to understand their own Emotional Intelligence and a follow-up view of their progress

- Two residencies of 3 days each: in-person, full-time sessions
- Six 1-hour individual coaching sessions for each participant (online)
